


Age of Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Principal Operators: 2002

Quick Facts About Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Farm and Ranch Operators


The 2002 Census of Agriculture is the most comprehensive source of statistics portraying our Nation's agriculture.

Information from the census of agriculture is used daily across America in all types of agricultural planning and decisionmaking. Whether decisions affect farmers at the county, State, or national level, the census is an excellent tool for providing information about all farmers and ranchers.


For 1992 and 1997, data were collected and published on Hawaiian operators only and Pacific Islanders operators were included with Asian operators as one category. For the 2002 census, data were collected for Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander operators as one category.

The 2002 Census of Agriculture counted 983 farms having a Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander principal operator.


Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Principal Operators - Farms by Size: 2002


