

### Sioux County - North Dakota Farms with Women Principal Operators Compared with All Farms





### Sioux County - North Dakota Farms with Spanish, Hispanic, or Latino Operators Compared with All Farms





### Sioux County - North Dakota Farms with Asian Operators Compared with All Farms







### Sioux County - North Dakota Farms with Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Operators Compared with All Farms





