
Lawrence County - Tennessee Farms with Spanish, Hispanic, or Latino Operators Compared with All Farms



Lawrence County - Tennessee Farms with Asian Operators Compared with All Farms



Lawrence County - Tennessee Farms with Black or African American Operators Compared with All Farms





Lawrence County - Tennessee Farms with Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Operators Compared with All Farms


